**Tuesday, June 5**

Visit the BBC for presentations by producers involved in 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary Beatles specials on TV and radio

Visit the British Library to see handwritten lyrics by John Lennon, a Gutenberg Bible from 1455, the Magna Carta, sheet music of Handel's *Messiah* in the composer's hand, and Leonardo da Vinci's notebook

Daytrip to Liverpool: the Magical Mystery Tour

**Friday, June 8**

Lunch with a special guest at the Hard Rock Café

**Saturday, June 9**

Check out of hotel, depart for Phoenix
